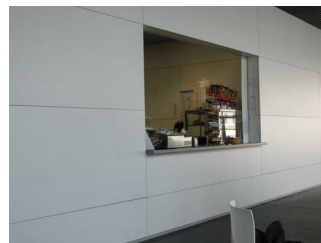

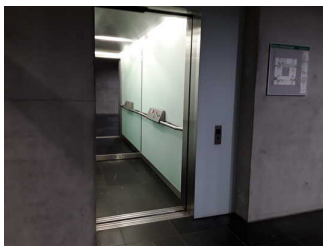

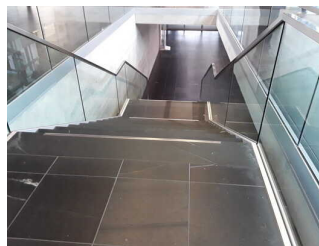

The guides are trained so that deaf people can participate in any guided tour. (Guided tour in sign language)

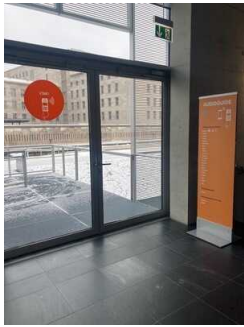
A reservation for the guided tour is necessary.

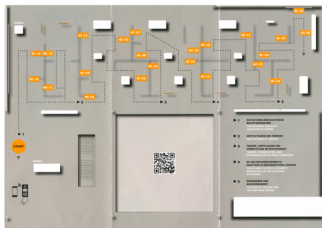
